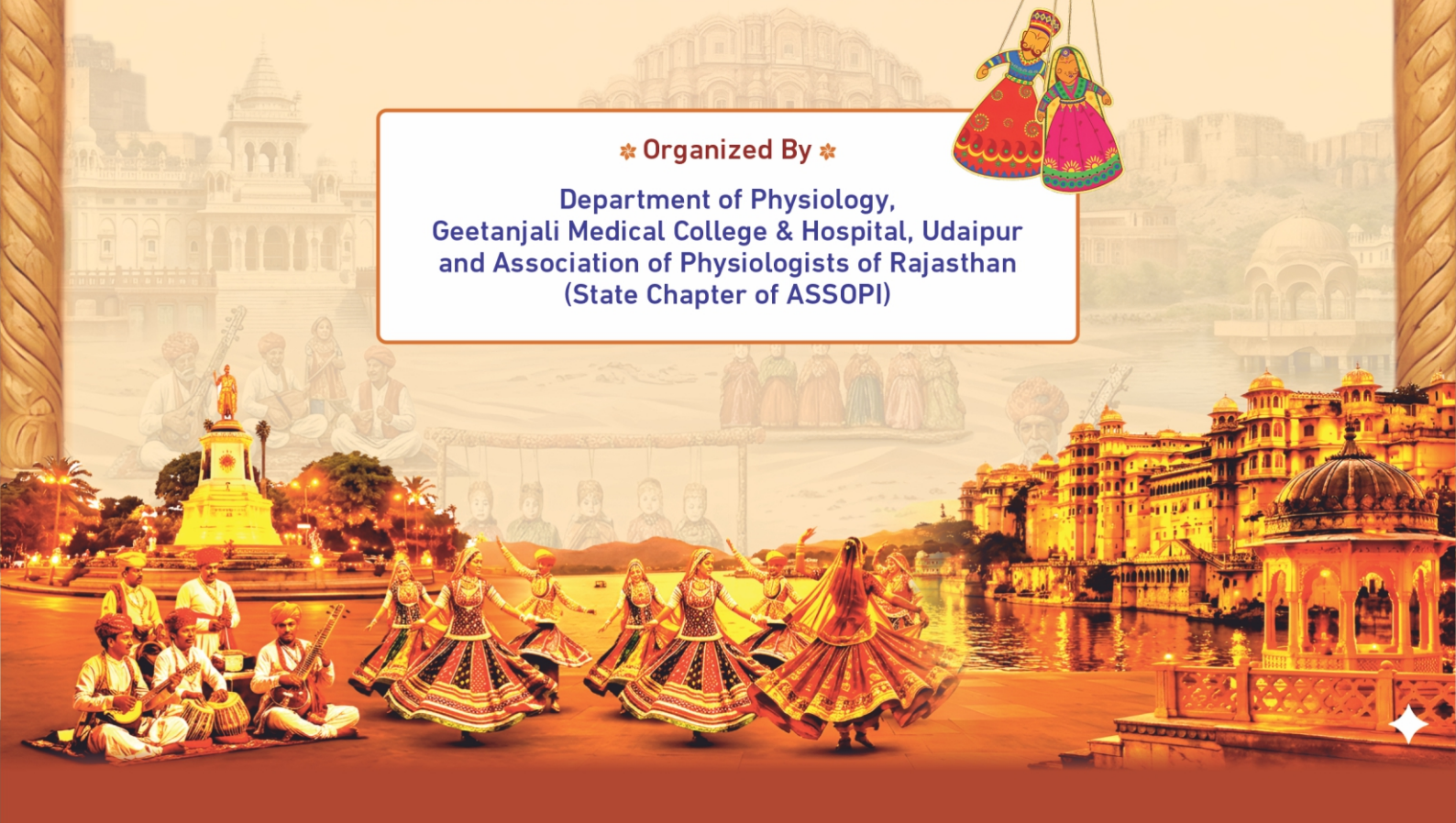

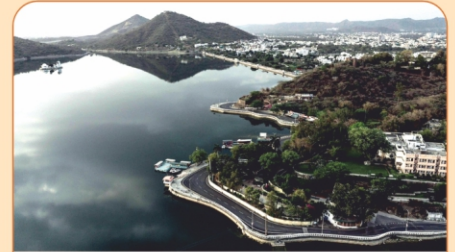
CITY PALACE UDAIPUR
