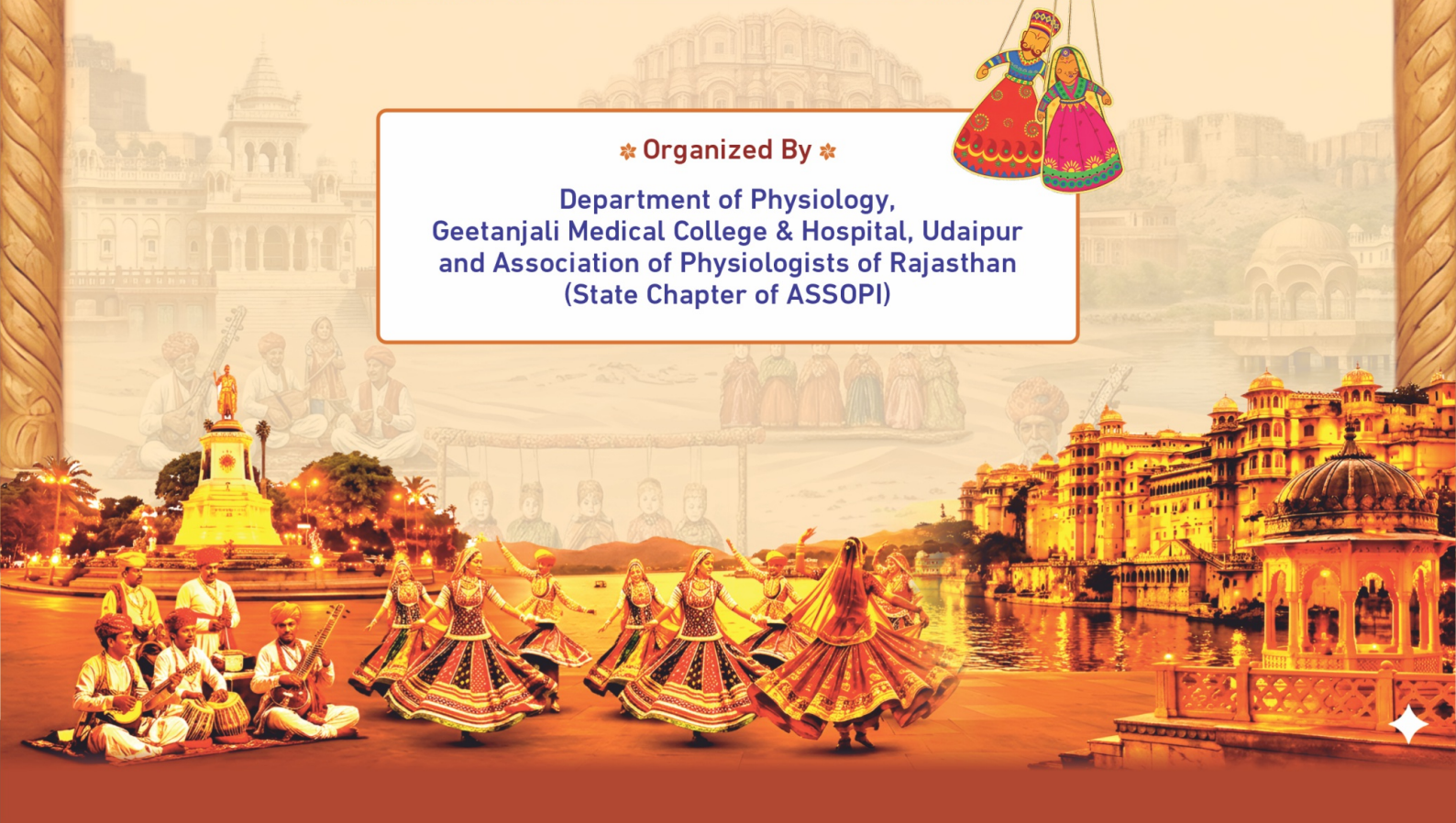

Conference Registration

Abstract Submission Process

All abstracts must be submitted exclusively through the official conference website.



Language

All abstracts, posters and oral presentations should be prepared in English.



300-Word Limit

Abstract Word Limit: 300 words.



Abstract Structure

Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusion.



Title Guidelines

The title of the abstract must be concise (maximum 40 words), should avoid abbreviations and should not end with a full stop.



Submission Policy

Each participant may submit only one abstract per category as the presenting author.



Review & Acceptance

All abstracts will undergo scientific review. The decision of the Scientific Committee regarding acceptance and mode of presentation will be final.

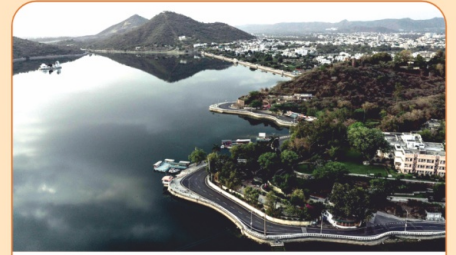
CITY PALACE UDAIPUR

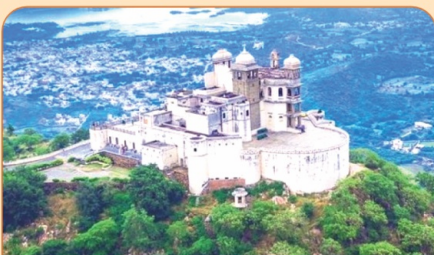
